| Rangefinding                         | Review written responses from the first administration of the ISASP to identify and select exemplar responses in preparation for scoring.  | Three days within the window of April 22-26; Pearson Campus in Iowa City; Compensation provided to districts for substitute costs if currently under contract with a district; Compensation provided to individuals that are not currently under contract with a district |
| Review performance level descriptors | Review drafts of the Performance Level Descriptors (PLDs) that operationalize the Iowa Core standards to describe the specific knowledge and skills necessary for classification into a performance level such as Proficient and Advanced. | One day of preparation (work completed remotely) and one day of meetings (Saturday, April 27); University of Iowa campus; Compensation provided to individual participants  |
| Standard setting study               | Participate in the review of student performance to determine the test score required to be Proficient or Advanced.  | Three to four days within the window of July 22-26; Doubletree Hotel in Cedar Rapids; Compensation provided to individual participants  |
| Item writing                         | Develop testing materials that are aligned to the Iowa Core Standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science  | Ongoing; Work remotely; Compensation provided to writers  |
| Item reviewer                        | Review test materials for content accuracy, accessibility and alignment  | Ongoing; Work remotely; Compensation provided to reviewers  |
