

## **ISASP Infrastructure Trial**

For those that were able to attend our Technology Readiness Training over the past two weeks, thank you for joining us to learn about your role in the Spring 2019 Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP). As discussed during training, this week we are inviting you to conduct a local Infrastructure Trial at your school/district. The local infrastructure trial will run 10/15 - 10/19.

This local infrastructure trial is a "mini dress rehearsal" for online testing. It does not use real student information, and is completed in the PearsonAccess<sup>Next</sup> Training Site. This is a low-stakes, dry run for confirmation that TestNav is configured correctly, your devices can successfully run TestNav, and your network can bear the full load.
