Infrastructure Trials have begun in PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>. An Infrastructure Trial is an opportunity for districts and schools to prepare for the computer-based ISASP assessments by simulating test-day network utilization and administration protocols. This will help to identify any school or district issues, and to confirm all testing devices are properly configured and ready to run ISASP assessments. Unlike a live assessment, you will not use real student information; instead you will create sample students in the PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> Training site.
