

Infrastructure Trial Reminder and Guidance

February 19, 2019

Thank you for your participation in the Spring 2019 ISASP Administration.

Infrastructure Trials continue to be run in PearsonAccess^{next}. An Infrastructure Trial is an opportunity for districts and schools to prepare for the computer-based ISASP assessments by simulating test-day network utilization and administration protocols. This will help to identify any school or district issues, and to confirm all testing devices are properly configured and ready to run ISASP assessments.

Unlike a live assessment, you will not use real student information; instead you will create sample students in the PearsonAccess^{next} Training site.

The Infrastructure Trial is a dress rehearsal to confirm that:

- TestNav is configured correctly
- Devices can successfully run TestNav
- Local Networks can bear the full load
- Participating staff know what to do for ISASP computer-based assessments

Most Frequently Encountered TestNav 8 Errors in ISASP Infrastructure Trials

| Error Number | Error Message | Addition Information and Instruction |

| 5036 | TestNav has detected Siri running in the background. Please disable Siri and sign in to TestNav again. | To disable Siri: Click the Apple icon at the top-left. Click System Preferences > Siri. Deselect the Enable Siri checkbox. Deselect the Show Siri in menu bar checkbox. Return to the TestNav Sign In page and sign in again. |

| 5037 | DictationIM_Detected | A blacklisted dictation service was detected on macOS. Disable the blacklisted service and have the student sign in again. |
| 1017 | Primary SRF location is not writable. Your responses will be saved in Alternate save location only. You may choose to continue with the test or exit the test and make the save location writable. | TestNav displays this error when it tries to write to the SRF primary location, but fails. Check the path and verify it is valid, accessible, and that write access is granted. To update the path, sign in to Pearson Access ^{next} and edit the TestNav configuration. A valid SRF path is required for testing. |
| 1018 | Alternate SRF location is not writable. Your responses will be saved in Primary save location only. You may choose to continue with the test or exit the test and make the save location writable. | TestNav displays this error when it tries to write to the SRF secondary location, but fails. Check the path and verify it is valid, accessible, and that write access is granted. To update the path, sign in to Pearson Access ^{next} and edit the TestNav configuration. A valid SRF path is required for testing. |
