As ISASP results are shared with school districts, Iowa Testing Programs is requesting that the results be locally embargoed for one week (November 4 to 11). Please note, while you may share access and results internally with your staff, the embargo means these should not be shared or discussed publicly by you or members of your staff until the week of November 11. This one week window allows districts the opportunity to review, interpret and prepare local messages.
